### Membership For All

### Staffing

All staff members are selected for their maturity, dedication, enthusiasm, and desire to work with children. Men and women are recruited from colleges and universities around the country and have years of experience working with children.

Our entire staff are subject to , and national background checks, and is CPR and First-Aid certified and participates in an intensive week-long training program that covers safety, supervision, counseling and camp procedures. Findlay YMCA average counselor-to-camp ratios exceed a state guidelines to ensure that your child receives the best care and attention possible. ### Refund/Transfer Policy

Registration fees are covered in the total session fee.

Registration fees are non-refundable under any circumstances. Up to the Friday prior to the beginning of the specific camp session, all funds, less the deposit, are refundable and transferable within other day camp programs. On the Friday prior to the session all funds are non-refundable and non-transferable. A written physician-authorized note verifying illness or injury is required in order to transfer funds to a future registration once the session has begun. If a camper fails to show for a registered session without notice, there will be no refund issued. In cases of homesickness, dismissal, or voluntary withdrawal, there will be no refund of any fees.

## KIDVENTURE DAY CAMP (AGES 5-8)


