**There are numerous ways to make a planned gift to the Endowment of the Findlay Family YMCA. Here are five common ways to begin to plan your legacy. For more information please, contact us using the form included. Any of these gifts will allow you to be a member of the Y's Heritage Society.**

- **Current gift of cash or cash equivalents:** A donation given directly to the Y's Endowment.
- **Bequests:** designate the Y as a beneficiary of your estate by will trust or other instrument. It can be a sum of money, property or a % of your estate's residue.
- **Retirement Plan Assets 401(k), 401(b), IRA:** Donor names the Y as primary, partial or contingent beneficiary.
- **Insurance Policies:** Donor's name the Y as a beneficiary of insurance policy.
- **Charitable Trusts:** You transfer your cash or property to fund a trust that makes a gift to the Y. You receive a charitable deduction for the gift, your family receives the remainder at a tax savings.
- **Designated YMCA Funds at Findlay-Hancock County Community Foundation:** Donate to one of the Y funds to support the mission of the Y.
